**ORDER**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. On December 14, 2020, Hemlock Utility Services Ltd. (Hemlock) filed with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) an application to revise Section 19 (Liability of the Company re: Service) of its Electric Tariff Terms and Conditions. Hemlock proposes to include further liability provisions with respect to its supply of electricity to customers (Application);
- B. By Order G-142-12 dated October 4, 2012, the BCUC approved Hemlock's Electric Tariff effective May 24, 2012;
- C. In the Application, Hemlock states the requested changes will provide improved legal protection against claims that may be detrimental to its ability to provide electricity to the Hemlock Valley Area; and
- D. The BCUC has determined that the establishment of a public written comment process is warranted for the review of the Application.

**NOW THEREFORE** the BCUC orders as follows:

- 1. The establishment of a public written comment process in accordance with the regulatory timetable, as set out in Appendix A to this order.
- 2. Hemlock is directed, as soon as reasonably possible, but no later than Wednesday, January 27, 2021 to:
  - i. provide notice of the Application and a copy of this order to all registered parties in Hemlock's 2012 Revenue Requirements Application proceeding; and
  - ii. provide notice of the Application and a copy of this order to all Hemlock customers.

3. Any stakeholder wishing to provide comments on the Application is invited to submit a letter of comment by Wednesday, February 10, 2021.
